OUR MISSION

To provide vulnerable adults experiencing homelessness in Orange County with emergency and transitional housing to regain stability, well-being, and lasting self-sufficiency.



OUR SERVICES

EMERGENCY SHELTER

Allows participants to get off the streets and receive emergency shelter and trauma-informed support with the goal of transitioning into one of our longer-term programs receiving additional support and obtaining permanent housing of their own.

TRANSITIONAL HOUSING

Temporary housing allows time for our participants to heal and work towards restoring their lives. Meanwhile, our Housing Navigators work on permanent housing solutions.

COMPREHENSIVE SUPPORT

We offer access to individual and group therapy, case management, SUD treatment, physical healthcare, life-skills development, management of personal and professional goals, resource navigation, career & education exploration, resume development, employment readiness, job advocacy & support.

CONTINUED CARE

Our After Care Program provides up to two years of ongoing case management after participants transition into permanent housing. During this time, we track progress, identify and address challenges early, and support long-term stability and success. In addition to our After Care program, in 2025, we launched *Grandma's Family Tree*, our Alumni Network, to help graduates stay connected to a supportive community and access ongoing resources.

WHY SUPPORT US?

Because we believe that homelessness isn't just one person's struggle—it's a community's challenge. One transformed life creates ripples—strengthening families, uplifting neighborhoods, and inspiring change.

We're setting new standards for care, transparency and what it means to be restored to wholeness.
